It is not necessary to apply for a temporary license if you are coming from a country that has been implemented the CEPT-recommendation T/R 61-01. Within this recommendation you are allowed to visit other CEPT-countries without applying a license in the visited country. On the website of the European Radio communication Office (www.ero.dk) you can find information about this recommendation and the countries who has been implemented this recommendation. Primary the recommendation T/R 61-01 is valid for licenses with a full advance to the amateur radio frequencies. Secondary there is also a possibility for the so called "novice-license".

If you are coming from a CEPT-country that has not been implemented the recommendation, or from a country not member of the CEPT, you can be granted a temporary license in the Netherlands for a period <u>with a maximum of one year</u>.

This application shall be accompanied by a certified copy of a valid amateur radio license in the home country.
